FIRE AT WATERBURY.

DeWitt C. Greene's farm buildings near Colbyville, about a mile from Waterbury village, were burned late Puesday night. He was unable to rescue his stock from the l'arn and is head of cattle, and nine hogs were burned, with all his produce and farming machinery, and a part of the contents of the house as well. The cause of the fire is not known. The insurance amounts to \$3,600.
