
❖- Young Man Drowns In Lake Mansfield

Michael Morvant, 20 years of age, lost his life Monday afternoon in the wind chopped waters of lake Mansfield when a canoe in which he and his friend, W. S. Howe, overturned.

Morvant was the son of a Greenfield, Mass., tailor and was at the Lake Mansfield Trout Club as guest of W. S. Howe of Hinsdale, N. H.

Young Howe nearly lost his life in trying to save his friend. The body was recovered a little after eight that evening.

The Waterbury and Stowe Fire Departments had responded as did Motor Vehicle inspector Cleveland. Later the Enosburg Falls Department arrived with special grappling equipment and the body was soon recovered by representative from the Stowe and Enosburg Falls Department and Roland Lafayette of the local Department operating from a boat.

The Waterbury Department lost two pieces of equipment and an order has been placed for new, improved equipment.

A funeral director from Greenfield came on Tuesday and took the body of young Morvant back to his home in that city.
