

Awning Blaze Menaces Store In Waterbury

WATERBURY, June 13. — Flames from a match, said to have been tossed on the awning of Bailey's Department Store, South Main st., by some young boys last night at 10, burned the awning, broke a plate glass window valued at \$150, and ruined the window casing. Mr. Bailey said a new awning would cost at least \$60. The window measured eight by eight.

The block in which the fire occurred is owned by S. C. Crossman. The Waterbury Fire Department was called and the flames were quickly extinguished, but not before the heat had broken the window.
