He reportedly returned to their car, parked in a field near the reservoir, to see if Clark had returned. When he didn't find him, Holmes called state police.

Police in turn called the Waterbury Fire Department which started dragging operations, recovering Clark's

An attempt to revive the man with a resuscitator failed.
